Absolute charter of
Sherrill-Kerwood Free Library

This instrument witnesseth That the Board of Regents for and on behalf of the Education Department of the State of New York has granted this absolute charter incorporating Julia D. Pohl, Lena T. Coates, Susan Cagwin, Grosvenor W. Allen and Dathase Cassell and their associates and successors in office as a free association library, in accordance with the vote establishing the same, under the corporate name of Sherrill-Kerwood Free Library, to be located in Sherrill, Oneida county.

The library shall be administered by a board of five trustees, to be at first the persons who are named herein as incorporators, said trustees to serve in the order in which they are named hereinafore, for terms that shall expire December 31st, one each in the years 1951, 1952, 1953, 1954 and 1955. Thereafter, as such terms expire, their successors shall be elected by the members of the library association for a full term of five years, with power in the board of trustees, by vote of three-fourths of the members of said board, to increase or decrease the number of trustees to be not more than 25 nor less than five. Vacancies due to cause other than expiration of term shall be filled for the balance of the unexpired term by the board of trustees.

Voted, that the absolute charter of the Sherrill-Kenwood Free Library, located in Sherrill, county of Oneida, state of New York, which was granted by action of the Board of Regents on February 16, 1951; which absolute charter was amended by Regents action on November 19, 1993 and September 15, 2009 be, and the same hereby is, amended to delete census tracts numbered 360530301033054 and 360530301033048 and place them with census tracts numbered 360530301032054 and 360530301032048 according to the 2000 U.S. Census.
